

CLINTON CREST MANOR VISITING GUIDELINES

*We are happy to welcome you to Clinton Crest Manor to visit your loved one today.
Enjoy your visit.*

Please complete and sign the top section of the COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire, and read and sign the Visiting Guidelines prior to the initial visit.

Prior to each visit, visitors will be screened. Upon arrival visitors will be directed to the appropriate screening area depending on the location of the visit.

Visitors will not be permitted to enter the building if they:

- have a positive viral test for COVID-19 * Testing for COVID-19 is not required as a condition of visitation;
- exhibit any symptoms of COVID-19 irrespective of test result;
- currently meet criteria for quarantine;
- have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 infection;
- do not pass the screening questions.

Visitors will be asked about their vaccination status, but are not required to be vaccinated or show proof of vaccination as a condition to visit.

Visits will be based on individual residents' specific physical, mental, and psychosocial well-being and needs, staffing, physical space, and infection control and prevention practices that reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission. Individual quality of life is a priority.

To maintain the core principles of infection prevention and perform the required regulatory supervision services, it is preferred that in-person visits be scheduled.

Current visiting hours are as follows but are subject to change:

- 9:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
- Accommodations outside the typical visiting hours may be made upon request.

Due to the number of current employees, and size of our building, we may limit the number of visitors and others within the building at any given time so that we can promote social distancing and complete disinfecting after visits while meeting all residents' needs.

Because of limited space in resident rooms, it is preferred that the maximum number of visitors per resident not exceed two individuals. Residents with more than two visitors are welcome to use the lounge if available.

Visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult aged 18 years or older.

Visitors and residents must adhere to the core principles of infection prevention and control and Clinton Crest Manor's established policy.

- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be available for use before and after the visit.
- Please bring and wear a face mask or face covering that fully covers the mouth and nose at all times. A face mask will be provided if needed.
- Please remain in the dedicated visiting area at all times.
- Please refrain from eating and/or drinking or using tobacco products when on the premises.
- The visiting areas are arranged to promote social distancing. Please do not rearrange furniture, as six-foot distancing should be maintained at all times during the visit, unless both the resident and visitor are fully vaccinated.
