

CLINTON CREST MANOR VISITING GUIDELINES

We are happy to welcome you to Clinton Crest Manor to visit your loved one today.
Enjoy your visit.

Visitors are limited in number (depending on location of visit) per resident, per visit.

- One or two visitors are permitted for outdoor visits and lounge visits;
- One visitor is permitted if visiting in the resident's room.

Visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult aged 18 years or older.

Visits are limited to 30 minutes.

The visiting areas are arranged to promote social distancing. Please do not rearrange furniture, as six-foot distancing must be maintained at all times during the visit.

Visitors and residents must adhere to the core principles of infection prevention and control and Clinton Crest Manor's established policy.

- Bring and wear a face mask or face covering that fully covers the mouth and nose at all times. Alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be available for use before and after the visit. A face mask will be provided if needed.
- Visitors must remain in the dedicated visiting area at all times. Facility restrooms are not available at this time.
- Avoid contact with other residents during the visit.
- Avoid physical contact with the resident scheduled to visit and others while visiting (hand shaking, hugging, etc.).
- Please refrain from eating and/or drinking and from using tobacco products when on the premises.
- Any items brought to the resident should be given to a facility employee at the time of screening. Please do not hand any items you may have brought directly to your loved one. This includes cell phones, papers, books, etc.

Per the NYSDOH, Clinton Crest Manor staff is required to provide regulatory supervision and monitoring for all visitors to ensure compliance.

Visits will be immediately discontinued in the event of any positive COVID-19 cases of residents and/or employees. If this is necessary, all residents, families, employees, and the NYSDOH Western Region will be notified. The facility website and signage will also be updated.

The NYSDOH can suspend visits at Clinton Crest Manor at any time due to community spread infection or based on the Department's identification of failure to comply with any guidance or advisory.

Clinton Crest Manor reserves the right to restrict visitation at any point. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in restriction or revocation of visitation.
